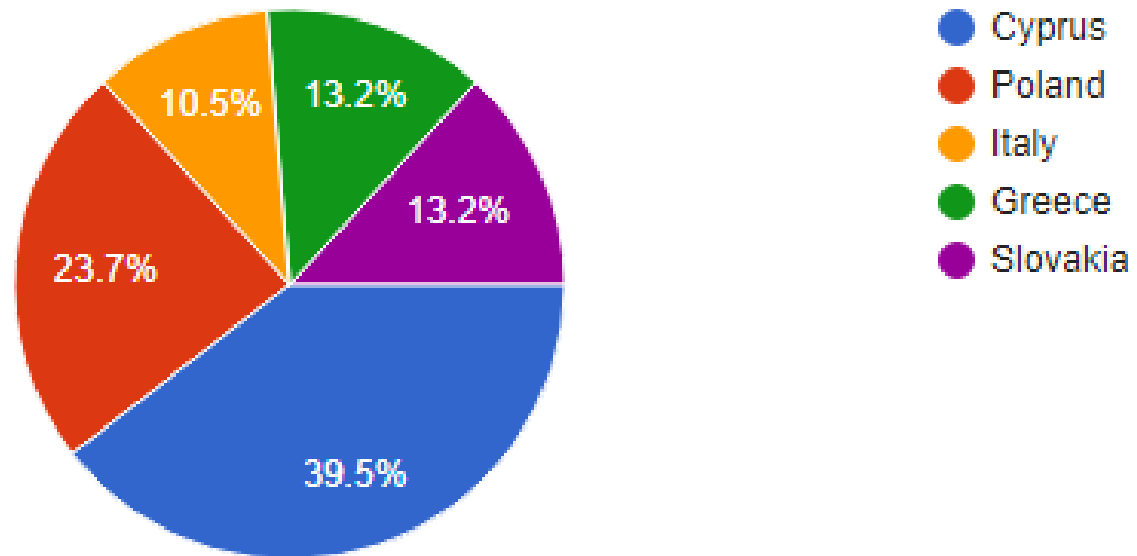

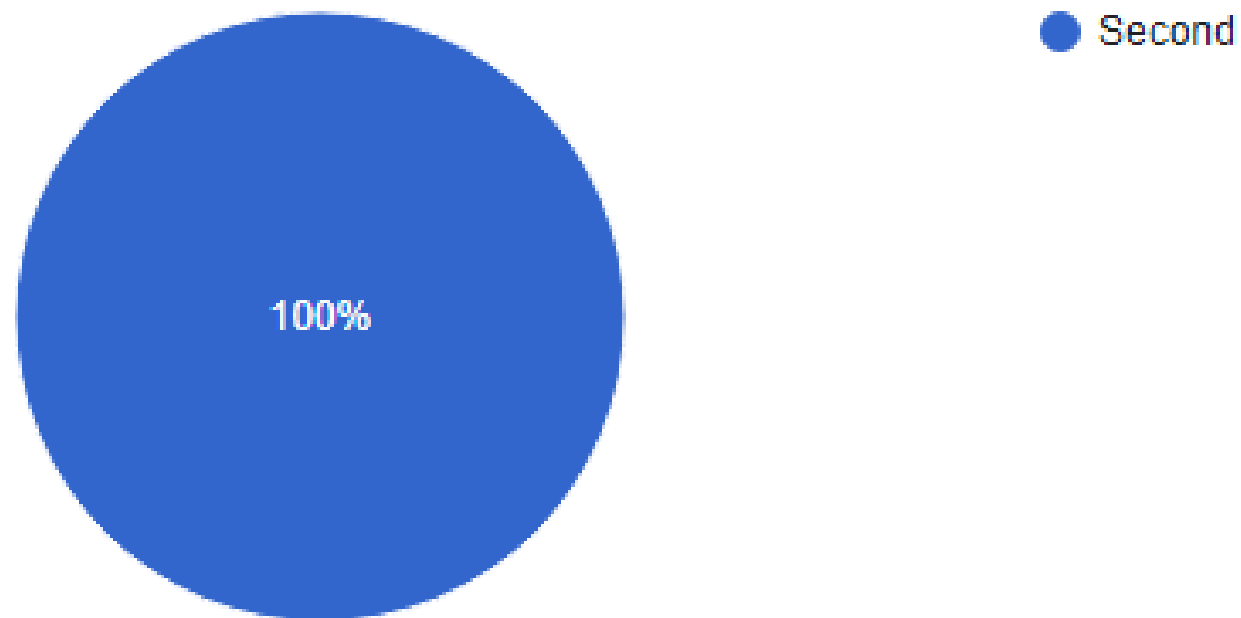
1) Which country do you represent in the Erasmus Plus project "STEAM"?

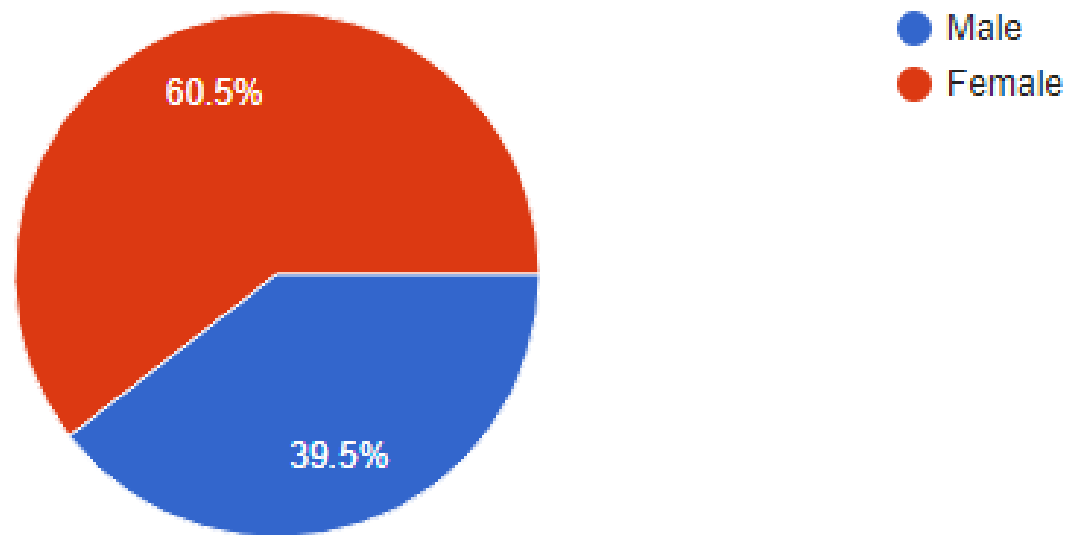

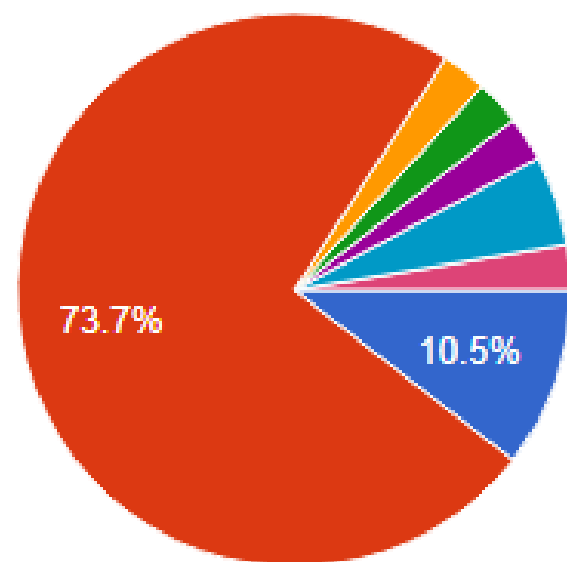

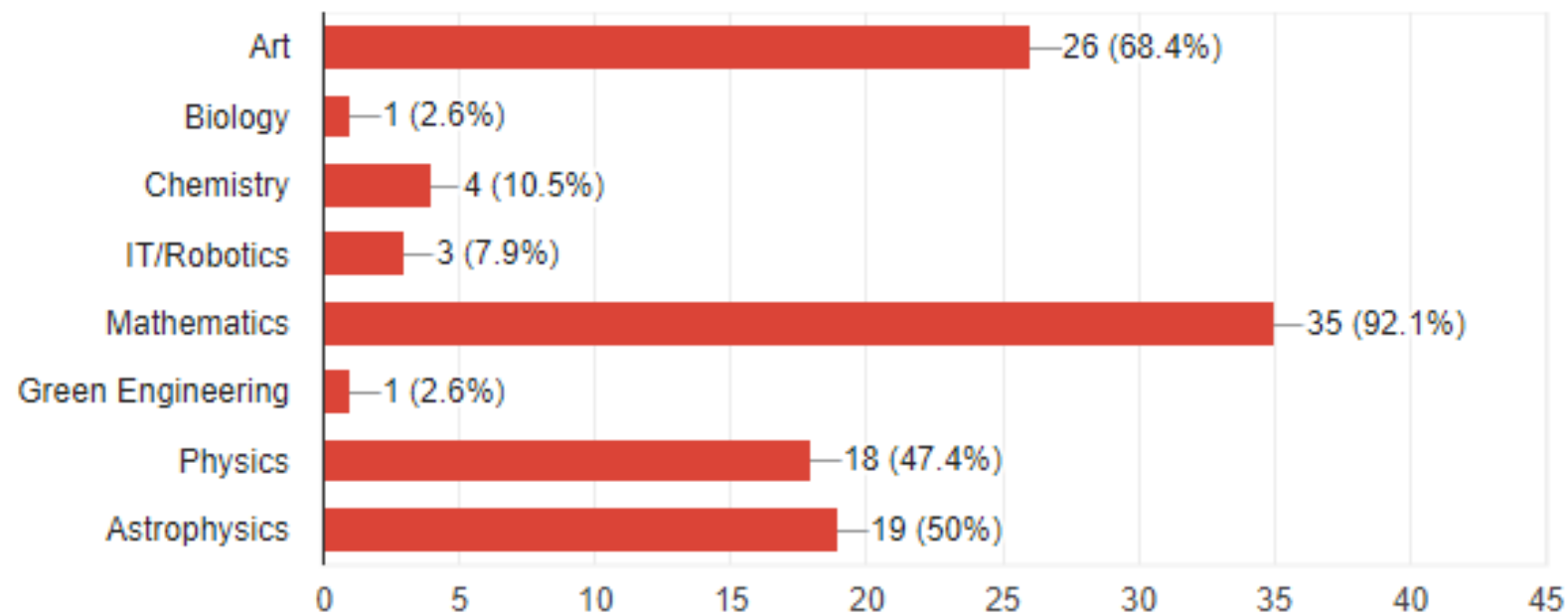

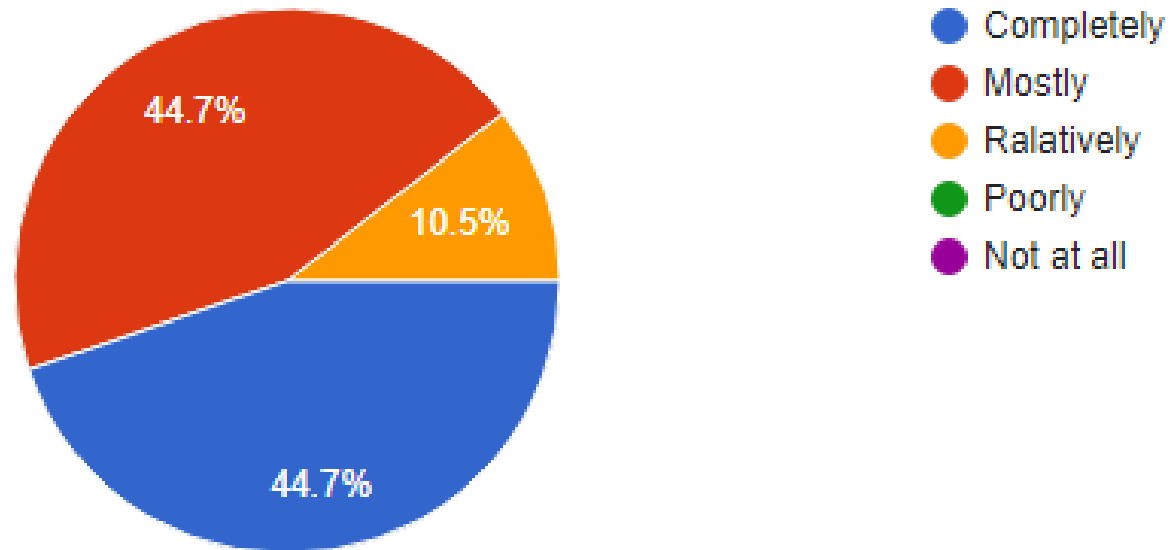

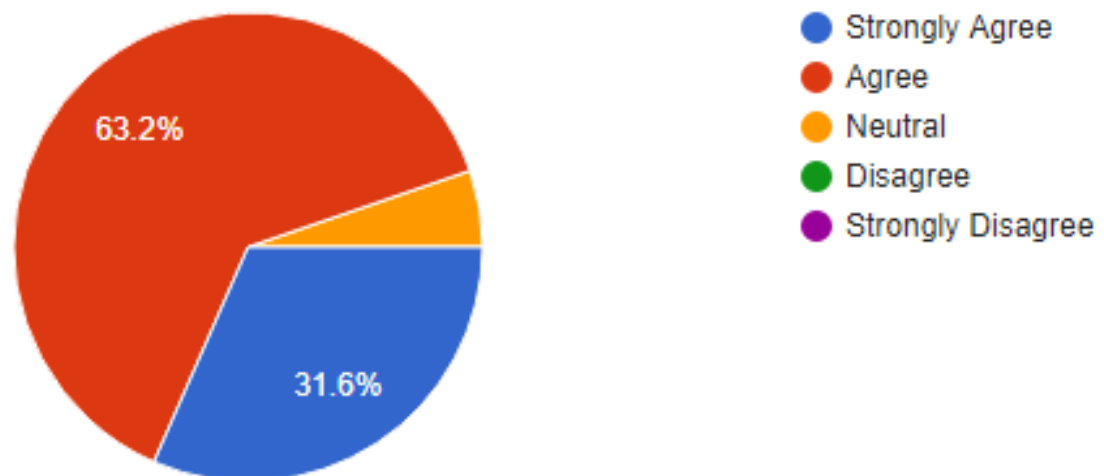

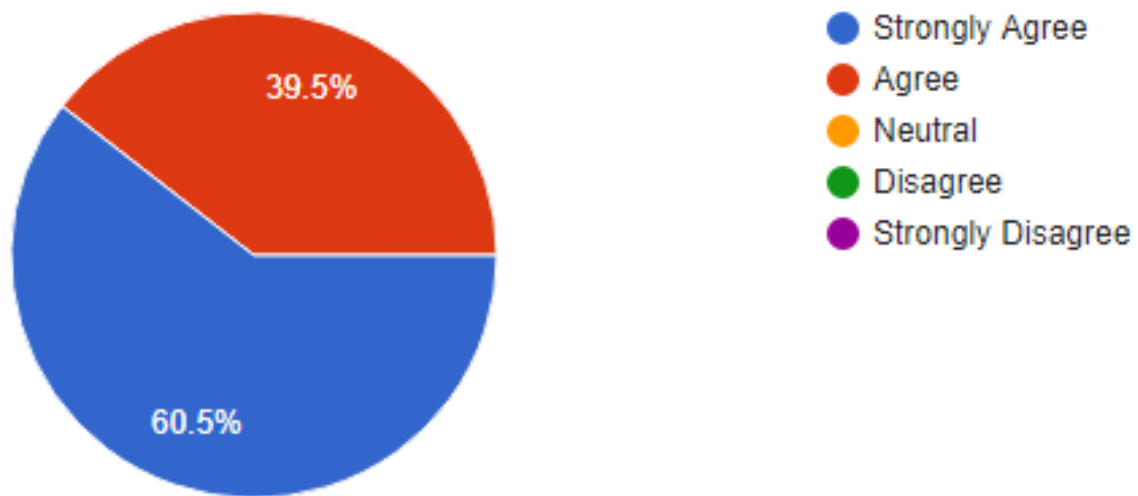

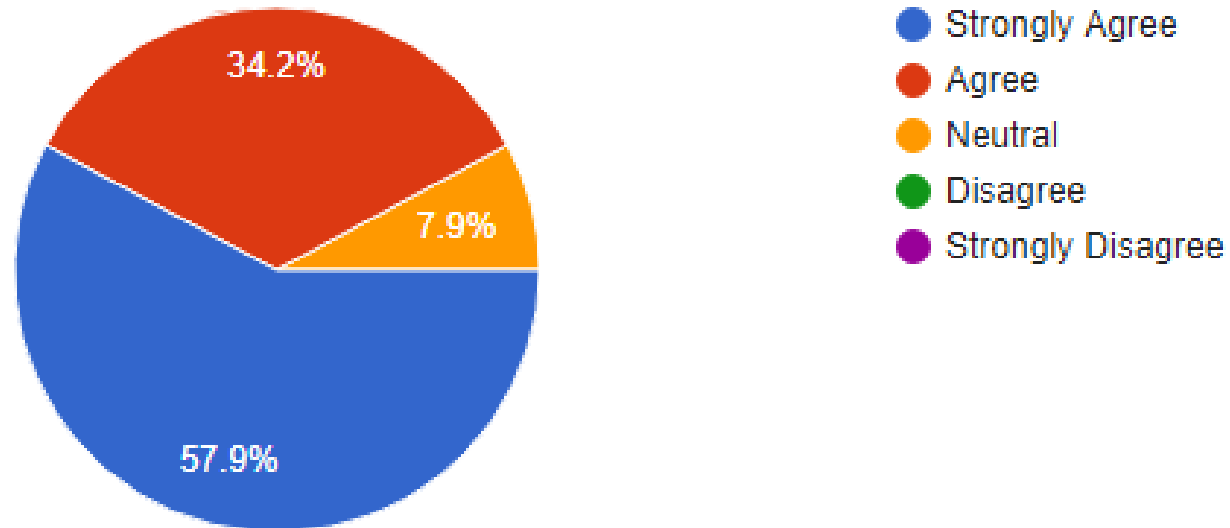
8) Do you believe you have developed or improved you communication skills?

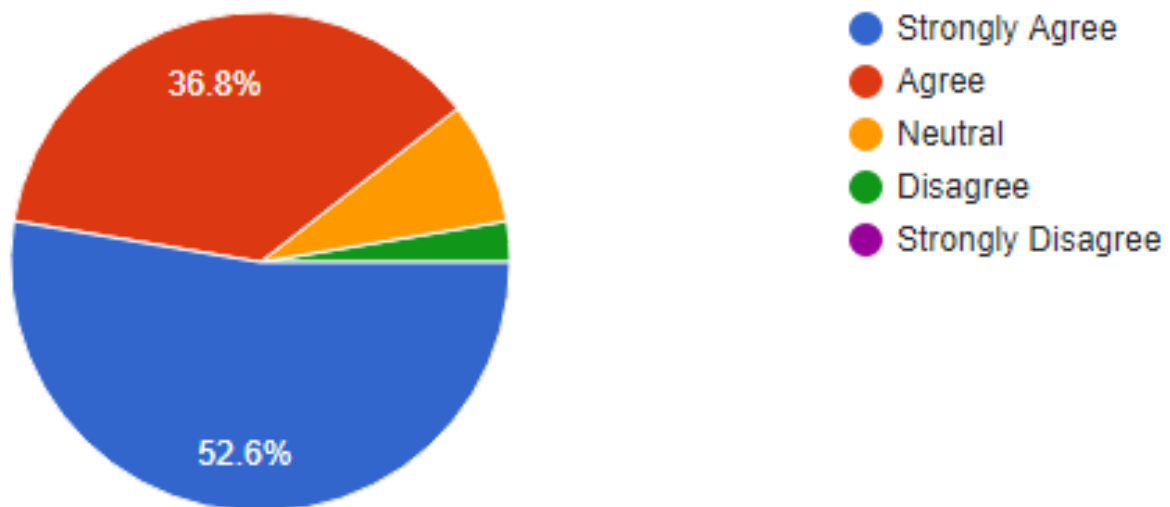

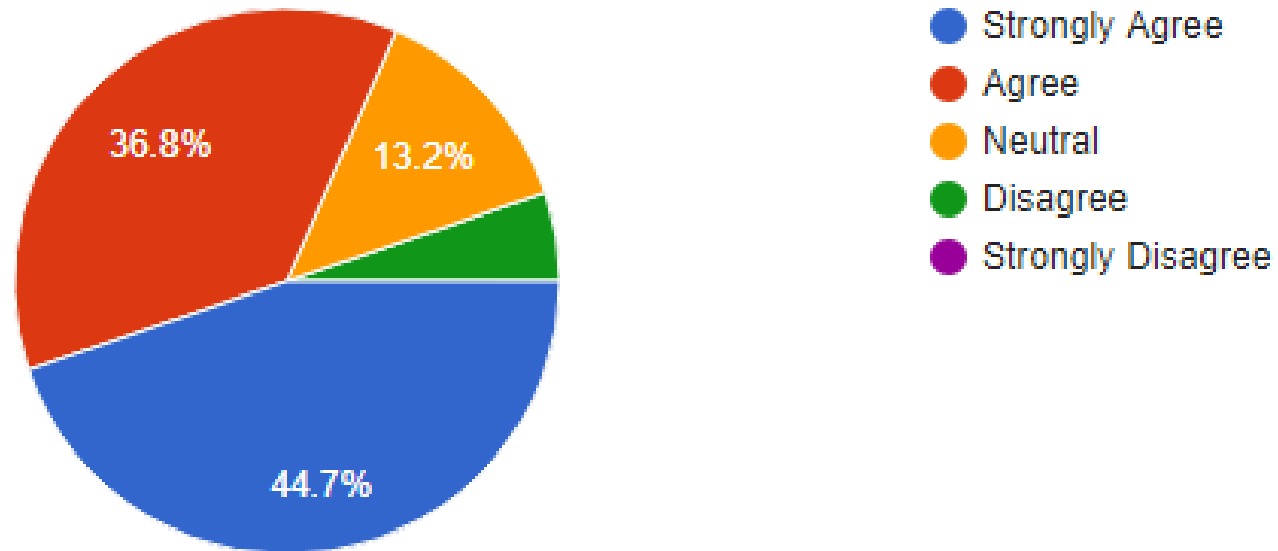

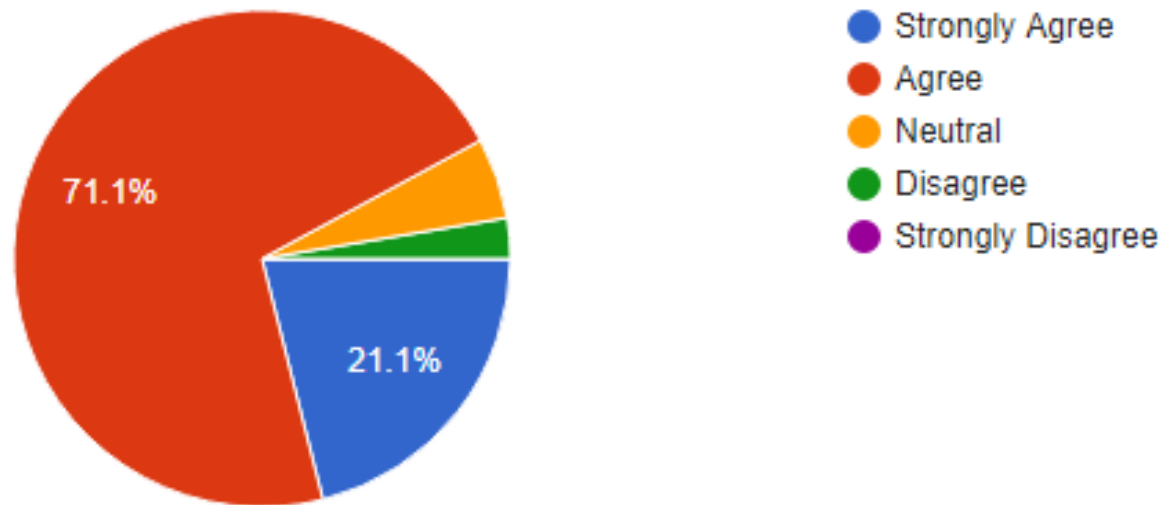

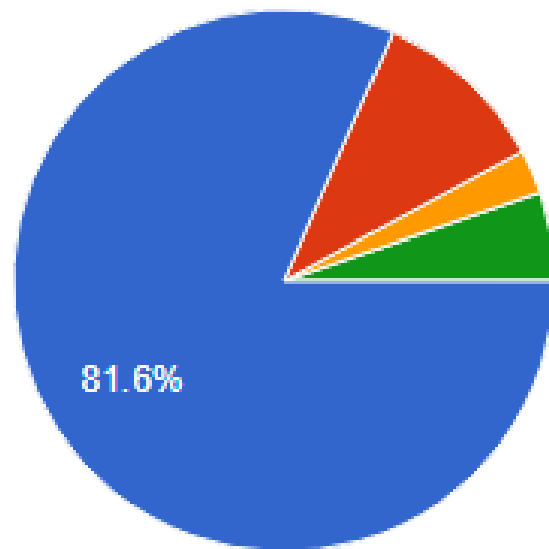

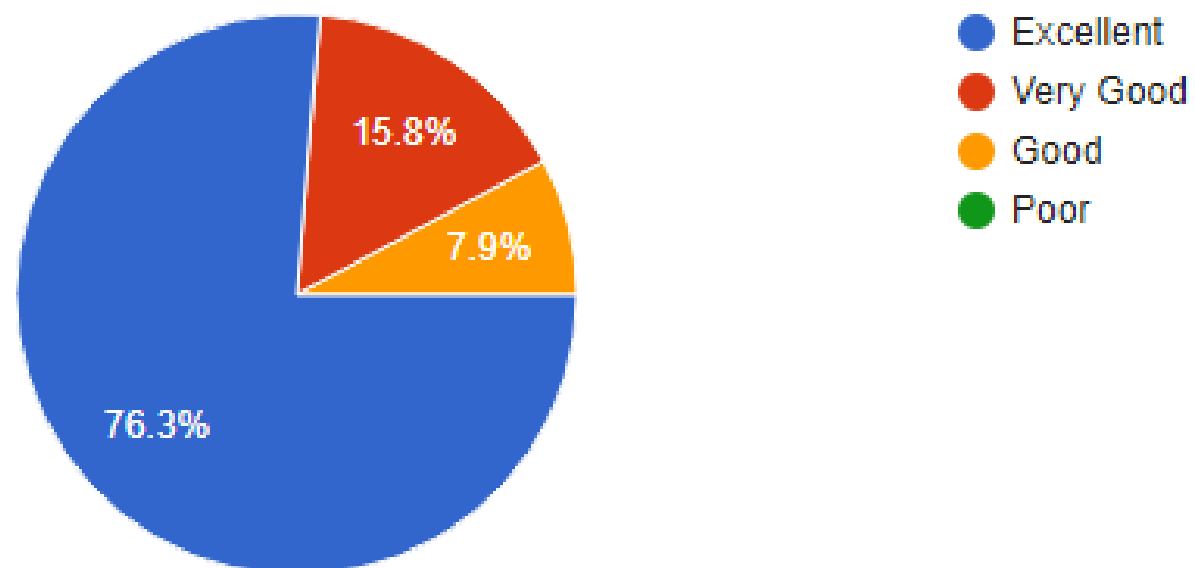
