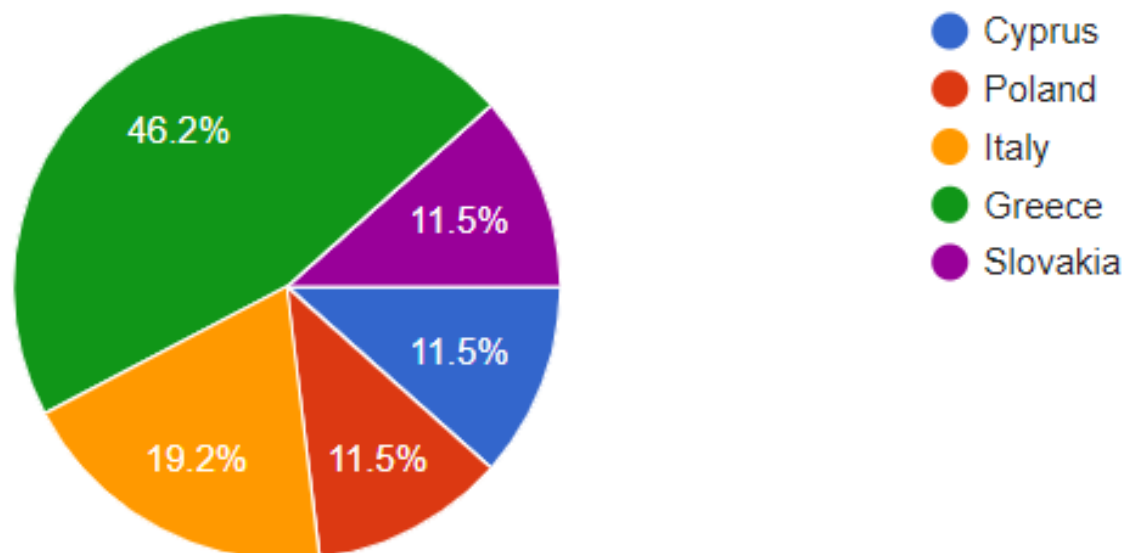

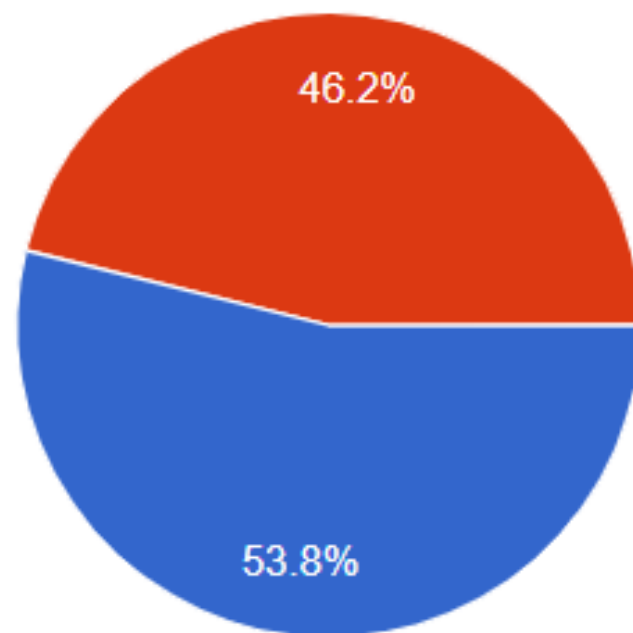

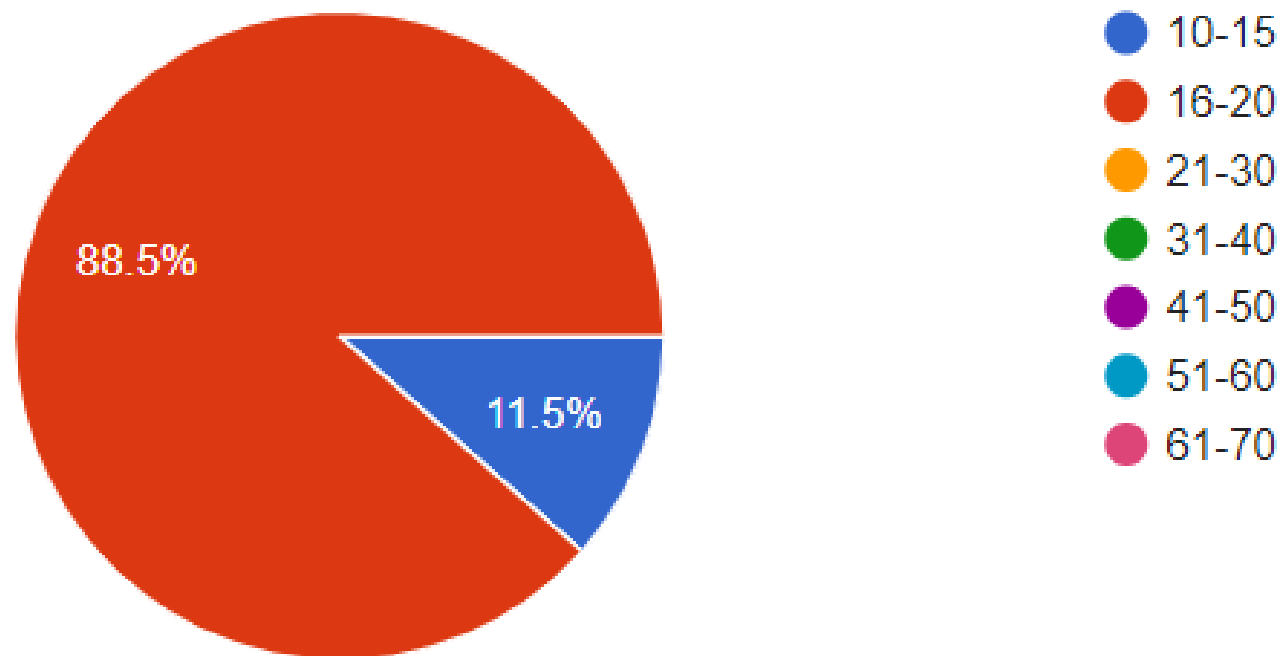

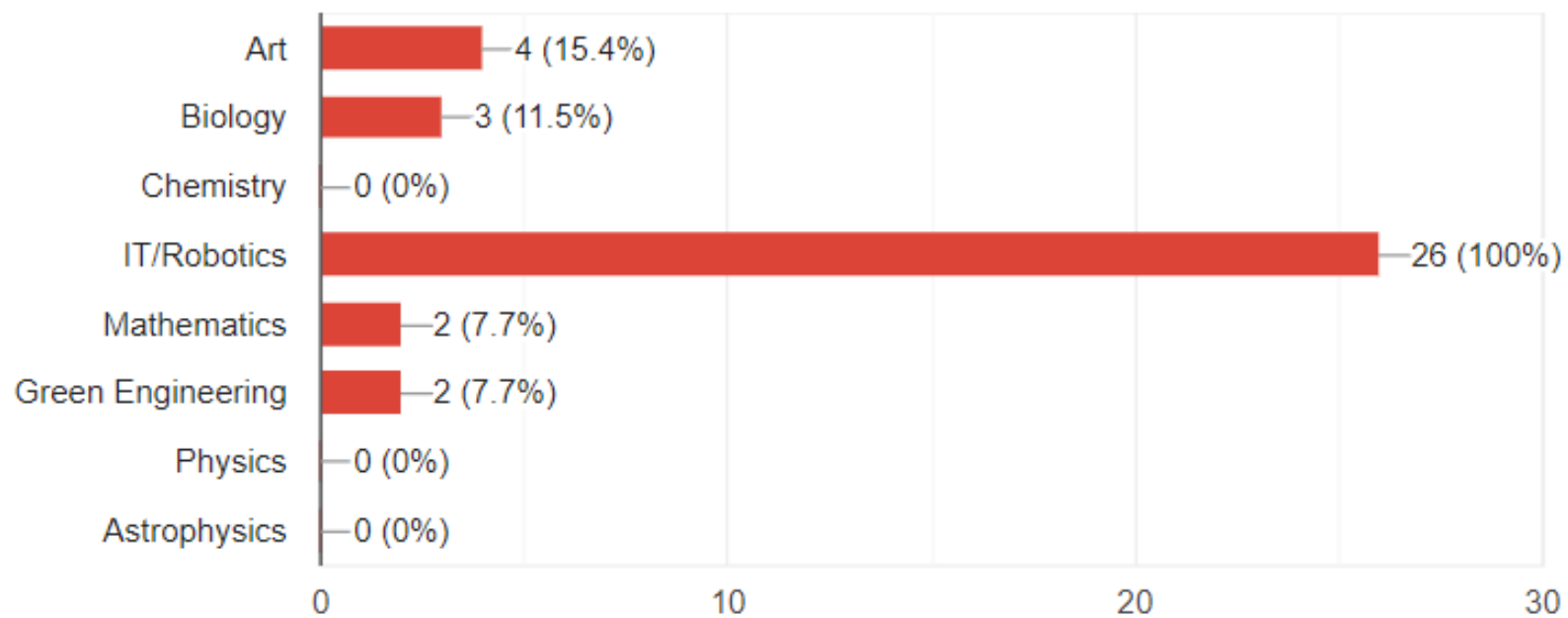

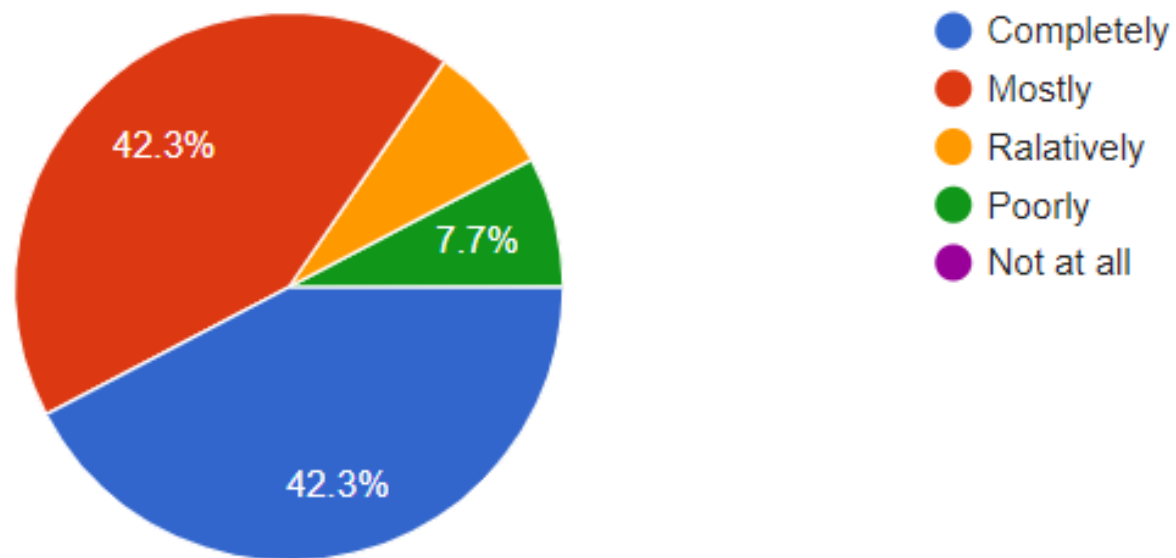
5) What were the targets of the short-term exchange?

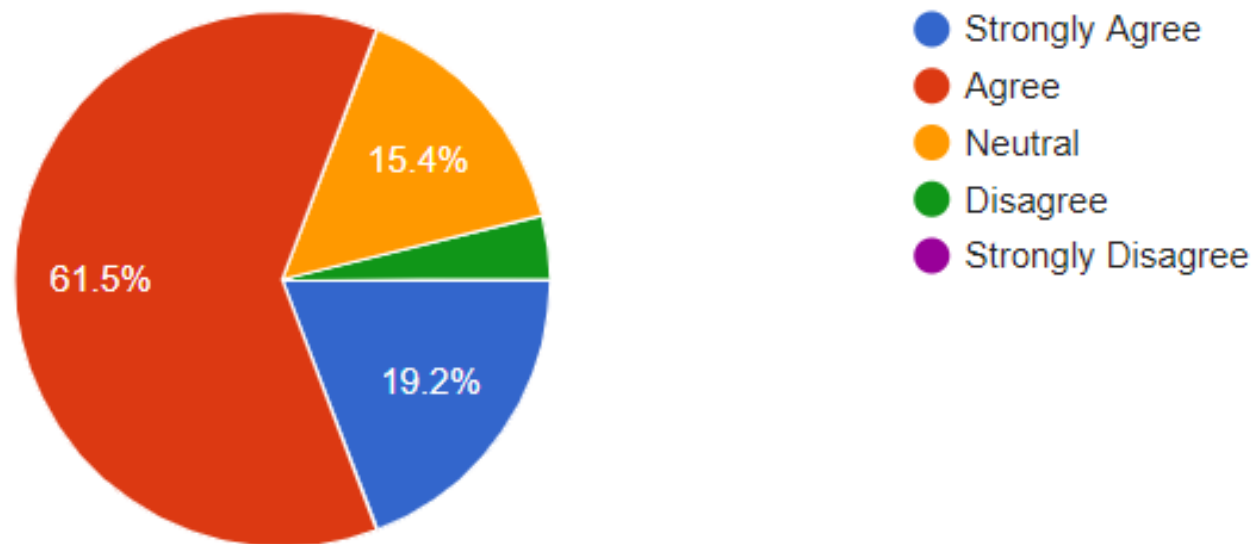

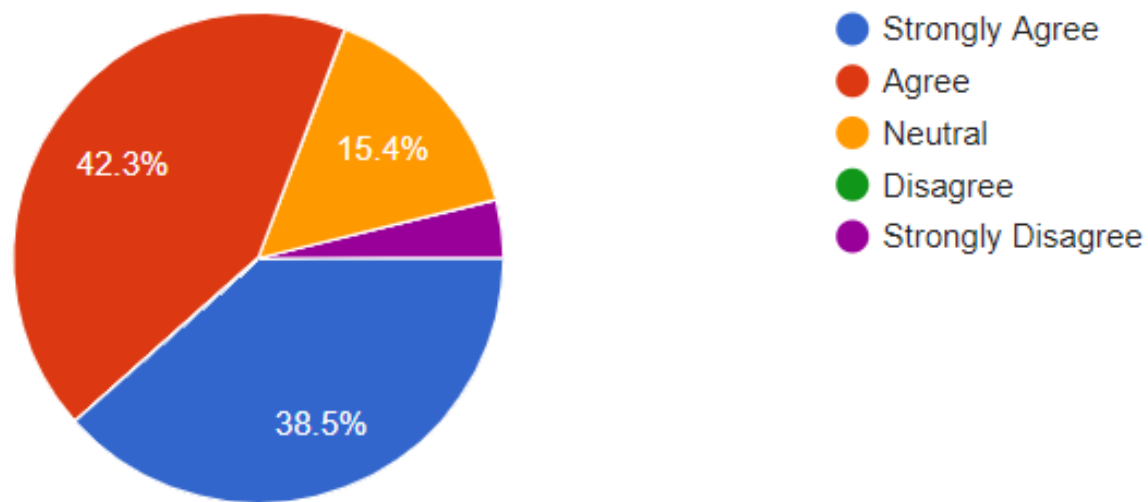

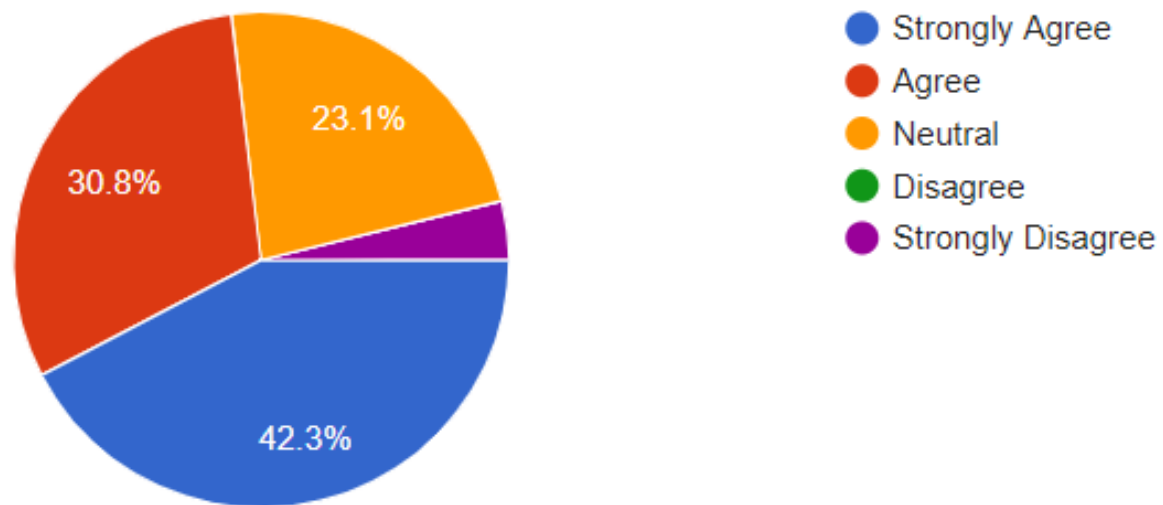

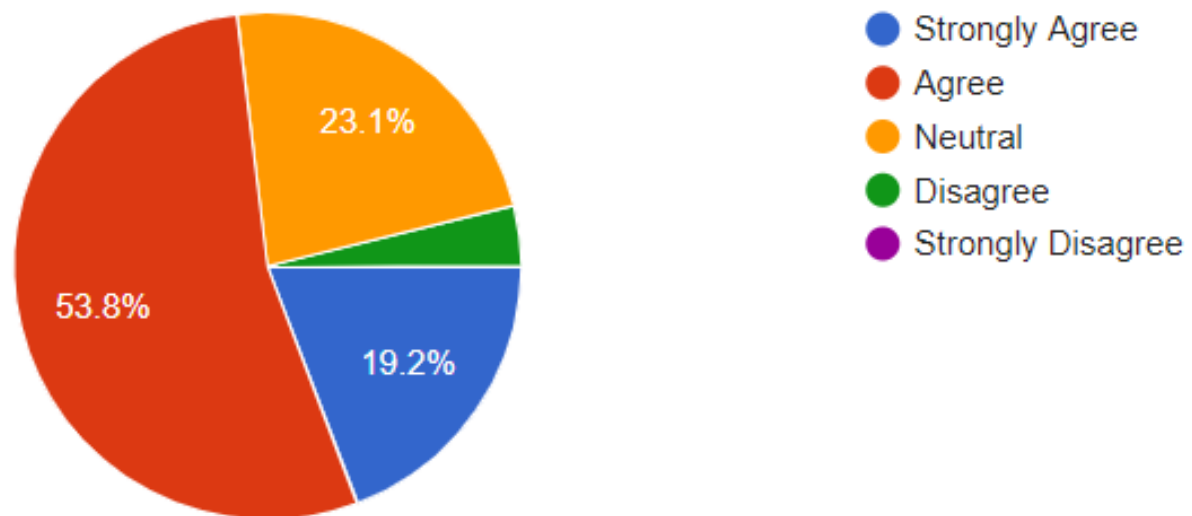

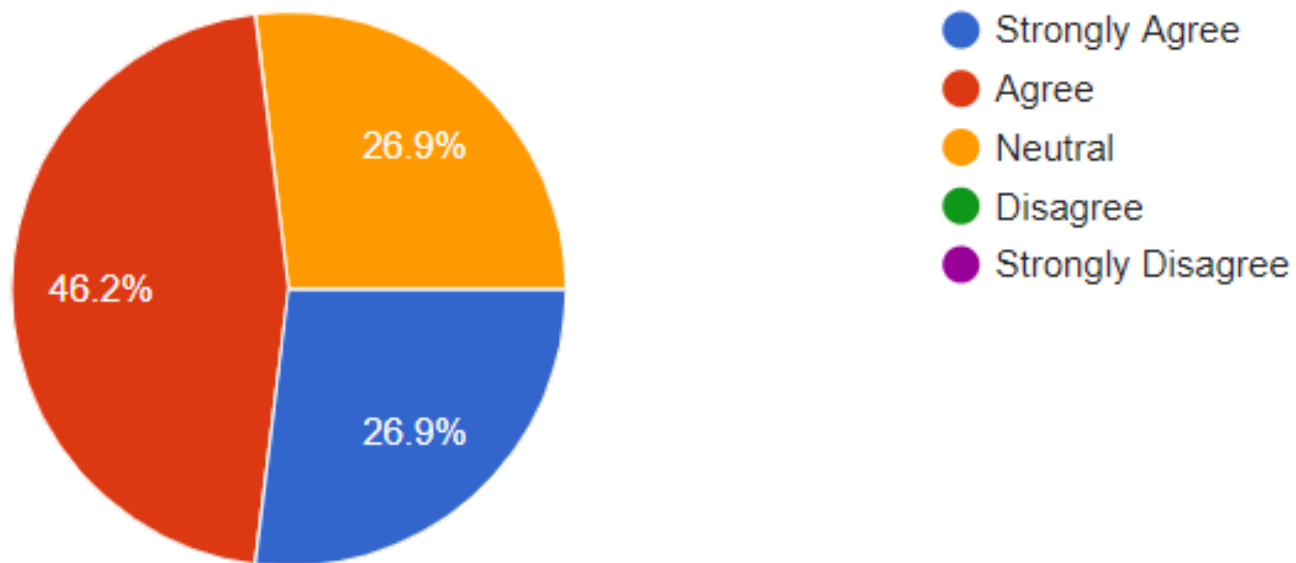

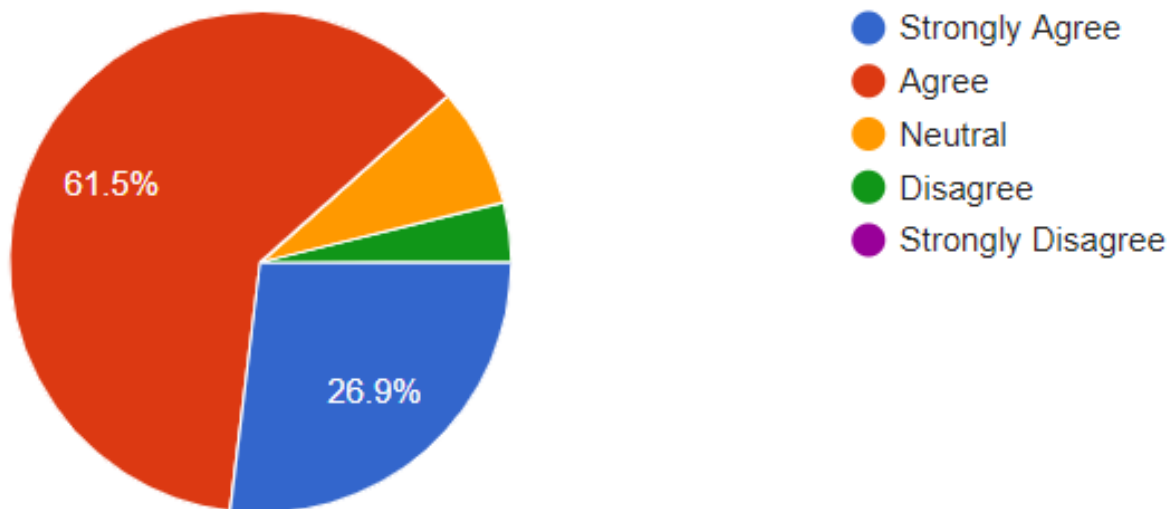

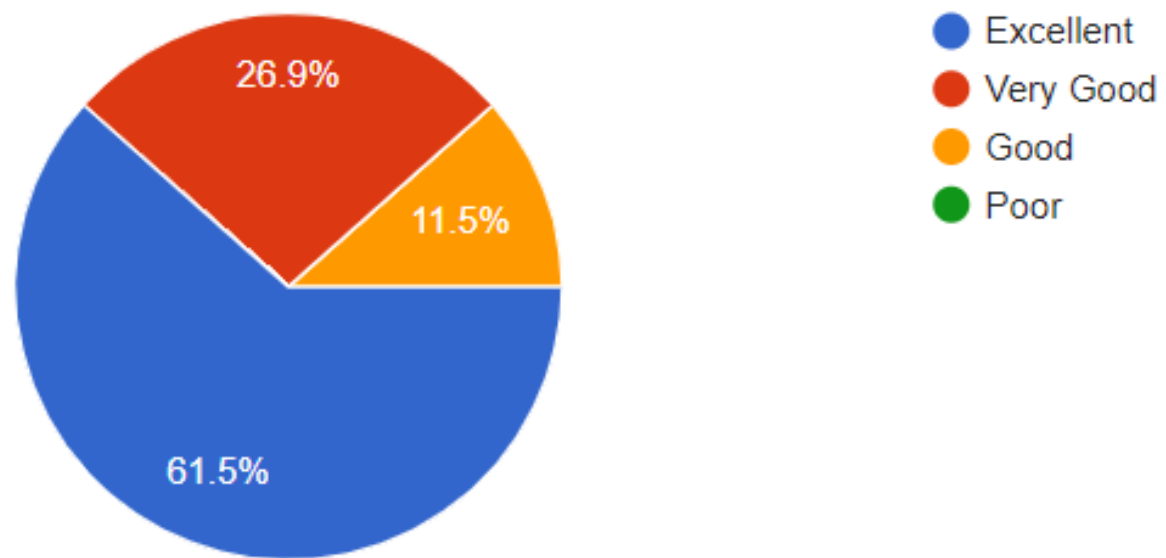

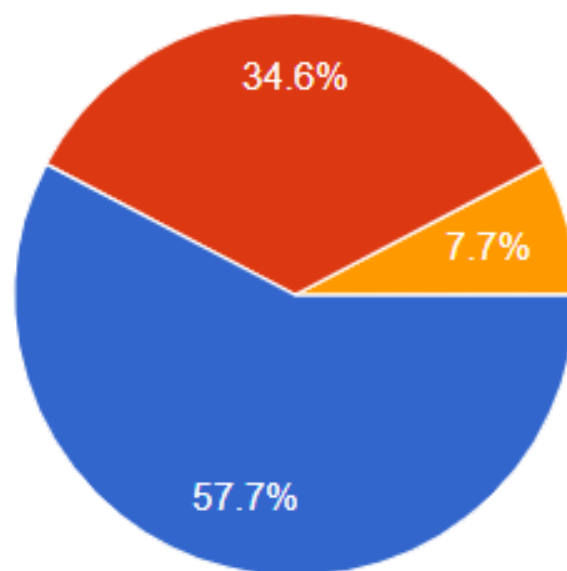
