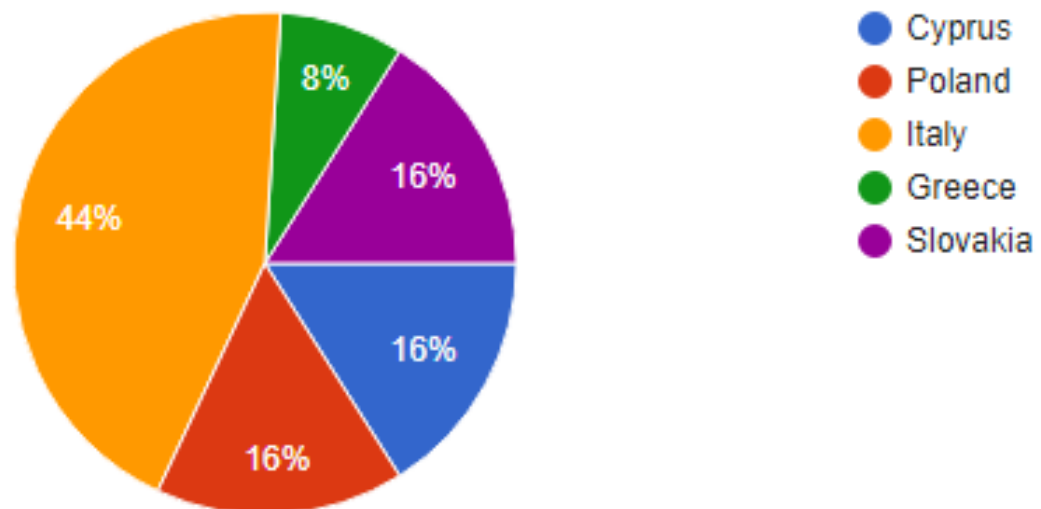

1) Which country do you represent in the Erasmus Plus project "STEAM"?

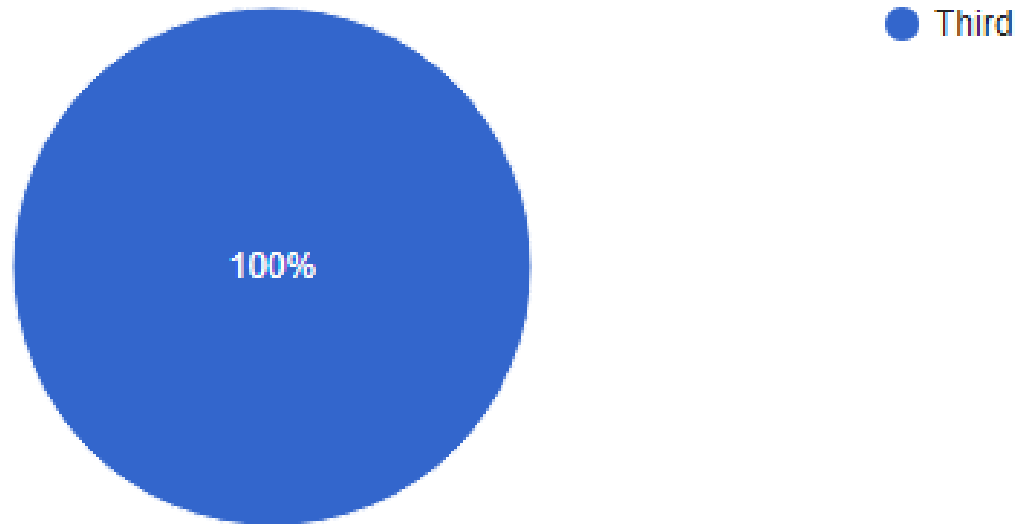

2) Order of short-term exchange mobility:

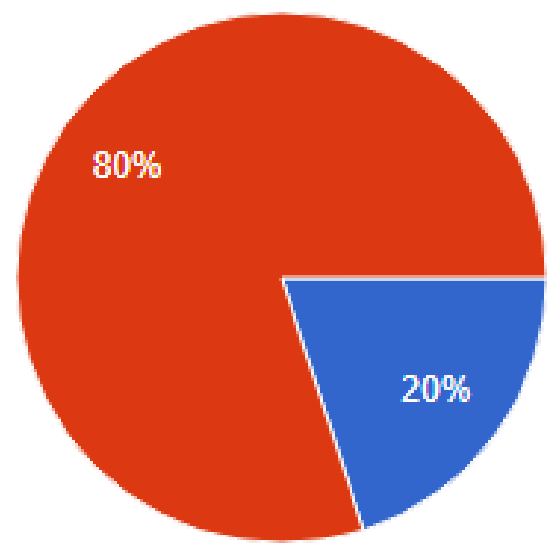

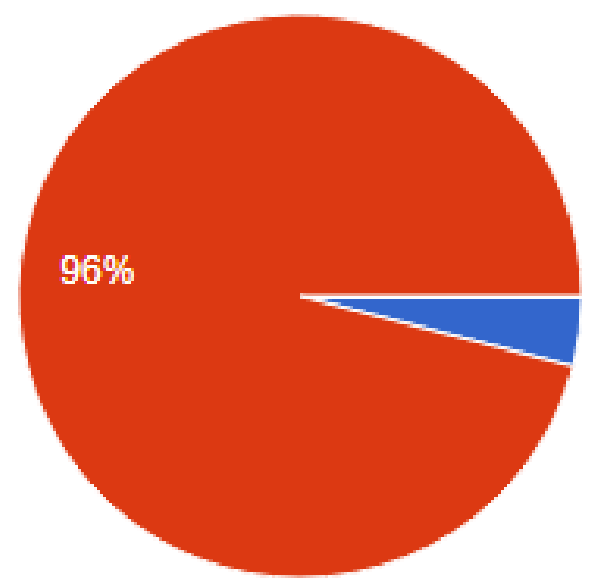

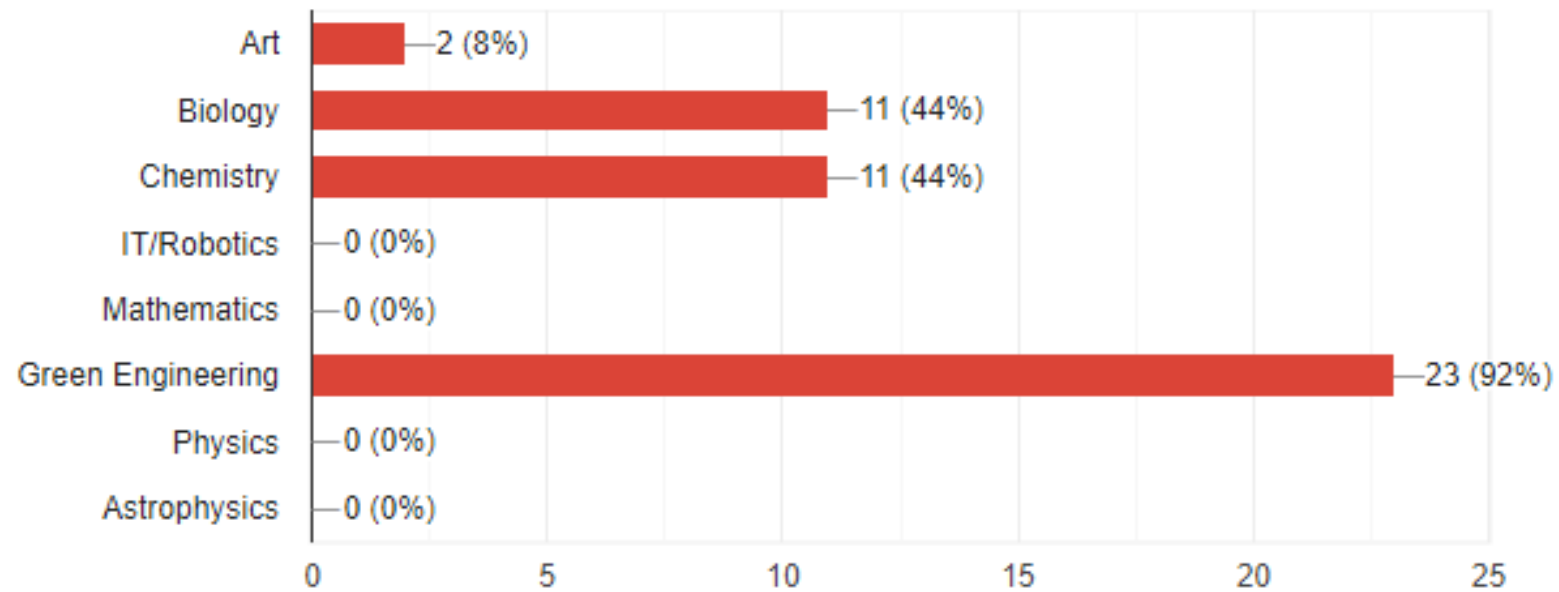

5) What were the targets of the short-term exchange?

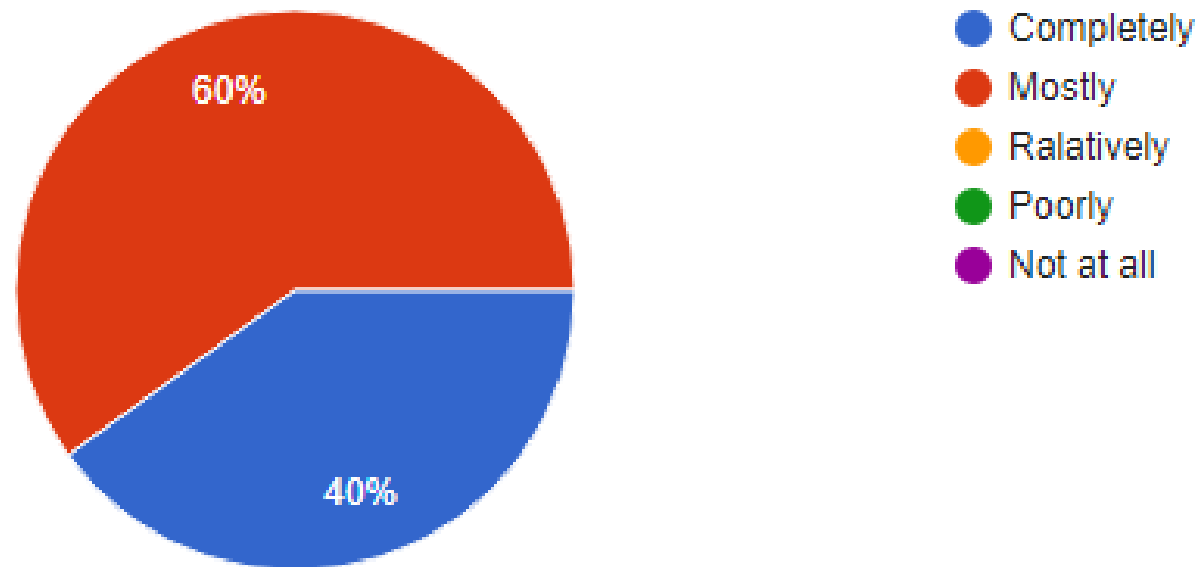

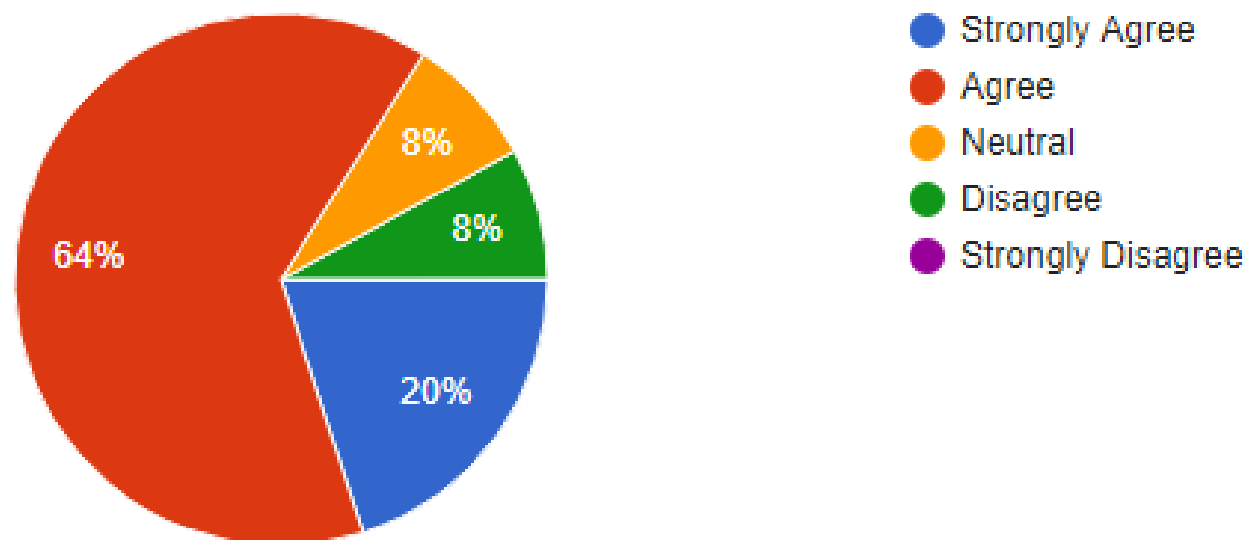
6) Did you understand the targets of the short-term exchange?

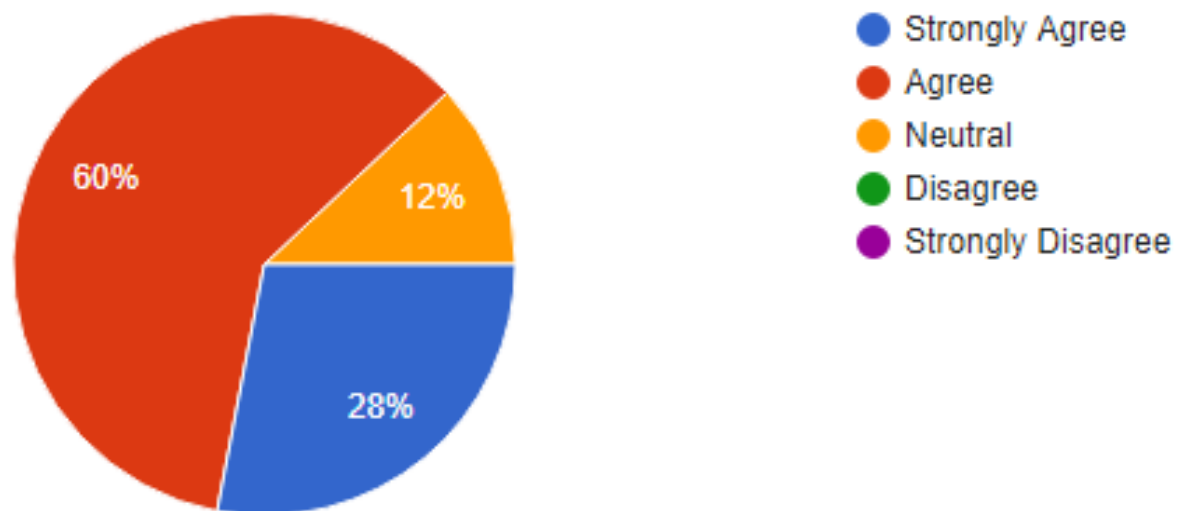
7) Do you think that the targets of the short-term exchange were met?

8) Do you believe you have developed or improved you communication skills?

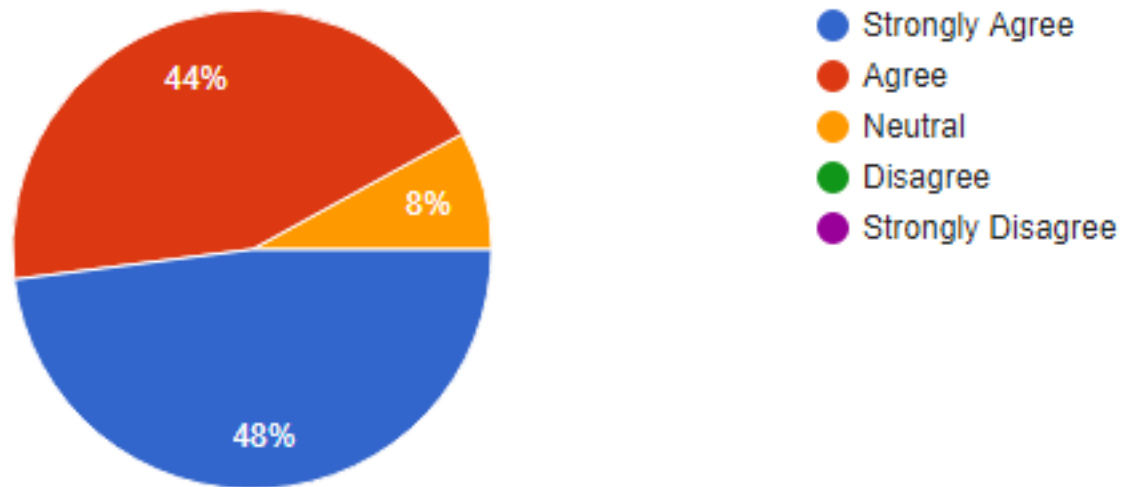

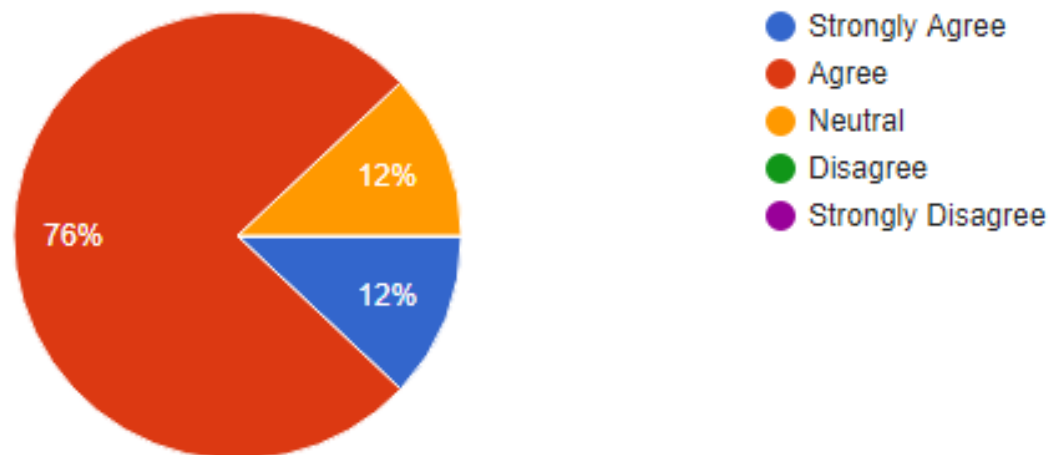

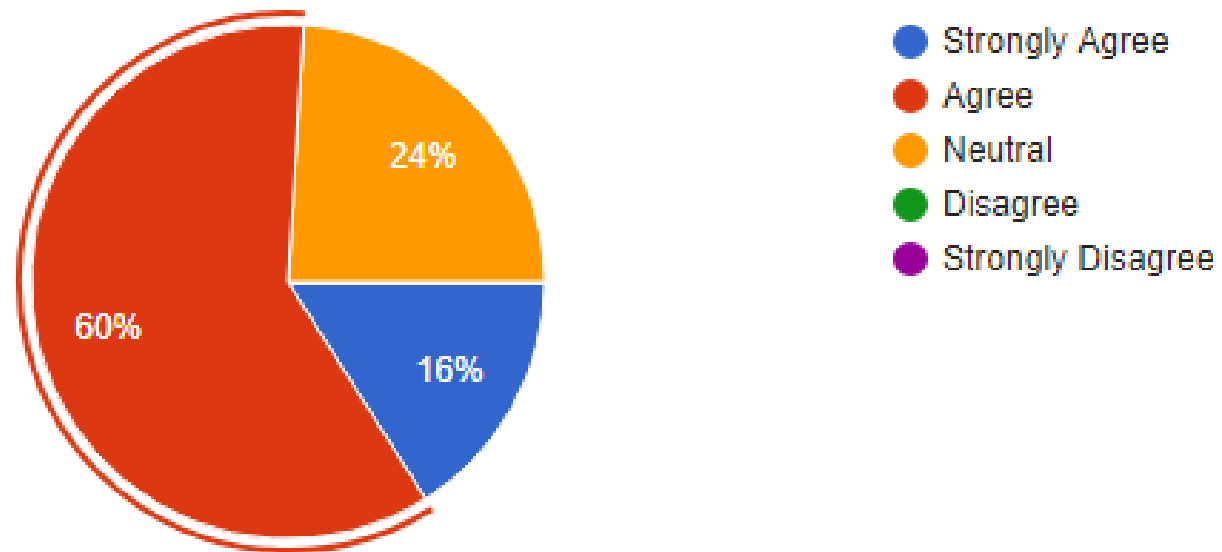

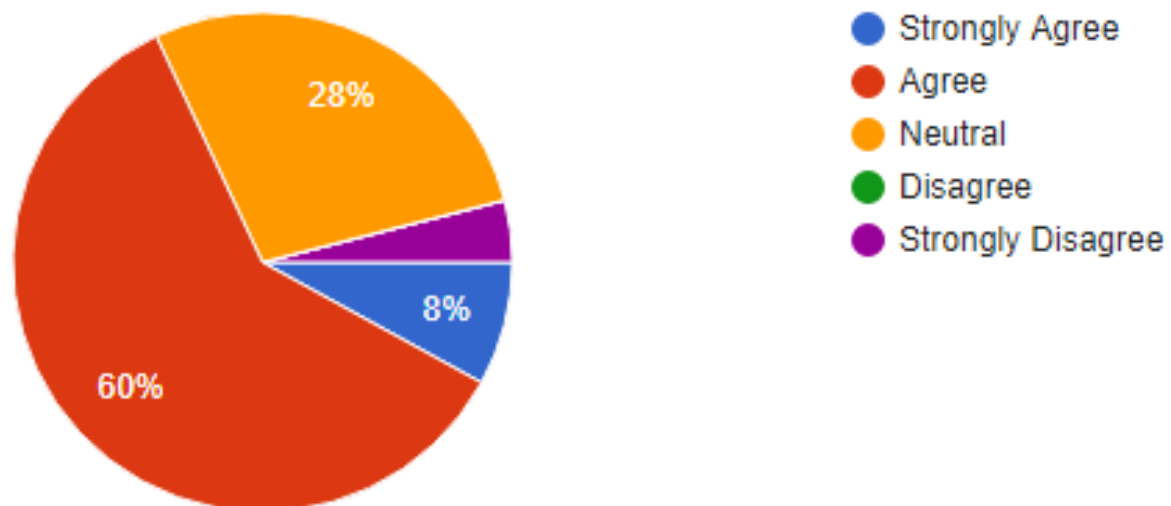
11) Were the workshops beneficial and met their targets?

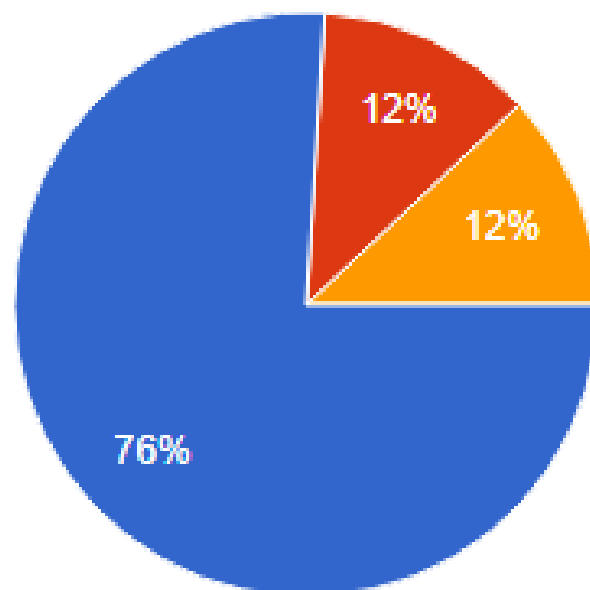

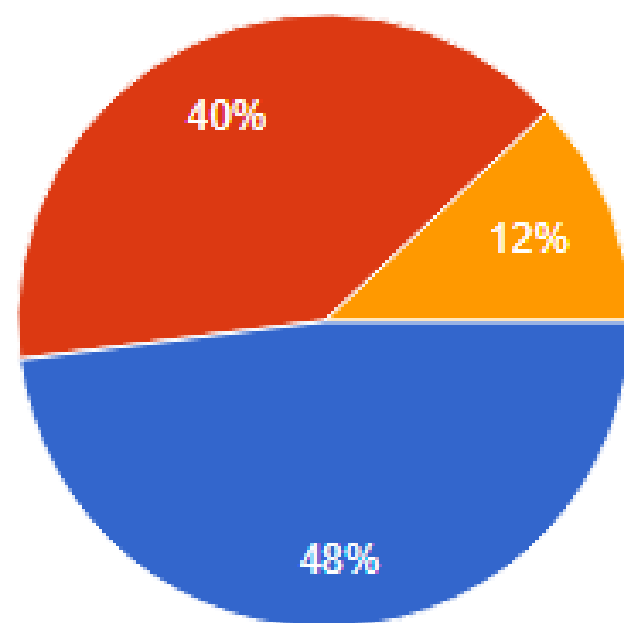
